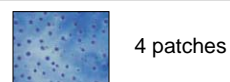
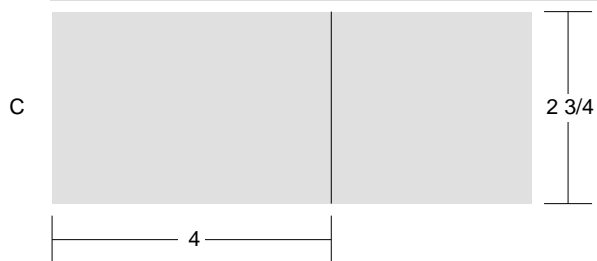
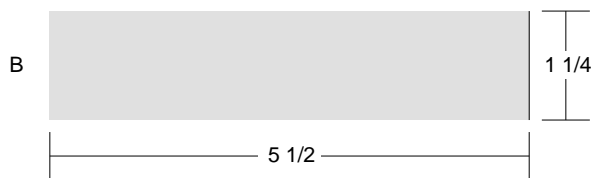
Key Block (31/100 actual size)

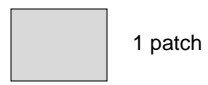


## Cutting Diagrams

## LQG BOM Modern

August -- Fall Fair

1. Cut all your fabric out according to the layout.
2. Using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance. Sew Piece A to C:

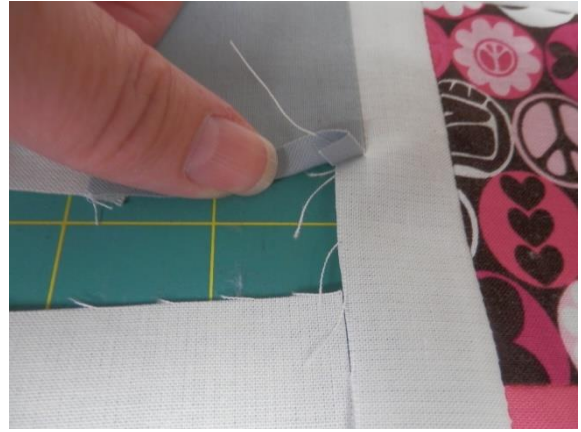


3. Sew a Unit B to the long edge of each A/C unit.



4. Check the arrangement to ensure all units are oriented correctly.

5. Place the centre block right sides together with 1 of the pieced units. Sew, leaving approximately 1 inch unsewn at the bottom. Press seam towards the pieced unit (if your long strip is white, you may prefer to press towards the center block, but this will increase bulk in the corners).



6. Add the next unit with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch seam, sewing the complete length. Continue adding the units, counter-clockwise around the center square.



7. After the fourth unit has been sewn in place, go back to the first unit (remember that you only sewed part way) and sew the remainder of that seam, across the end of the fourth unit, to complete the block.
