## Peek-A-Boo 8-inch Block

This is not a difficult block, but careful cutting is important, as is a *scant* ¼-inch seam allowance. Any block with triangles needs a seam allowance just a smidgen under ¼-inch, referred to as *scant*.

1. Cut pieces according to the cutting diagram and arrange right-side up.

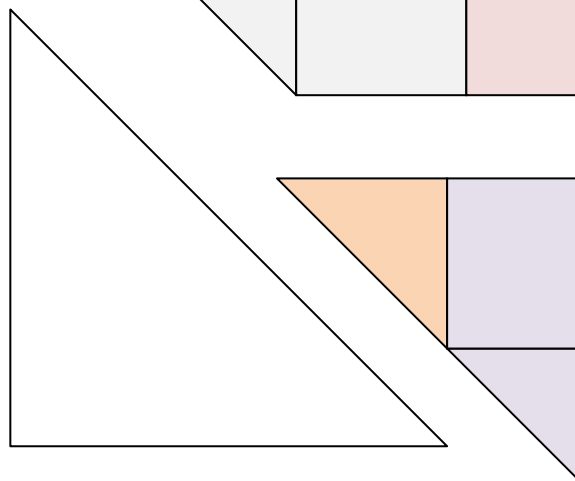


2. Sew **A** pieces to **B** pieces, pressing seam allowances towards the **B** pieces.

3. Sew piece **C** to an **AB** unit and press the seam allowance towards the **C** piece.

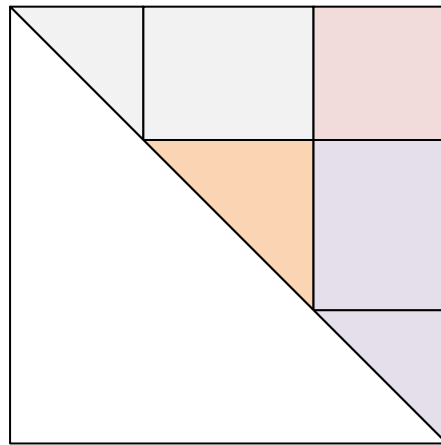
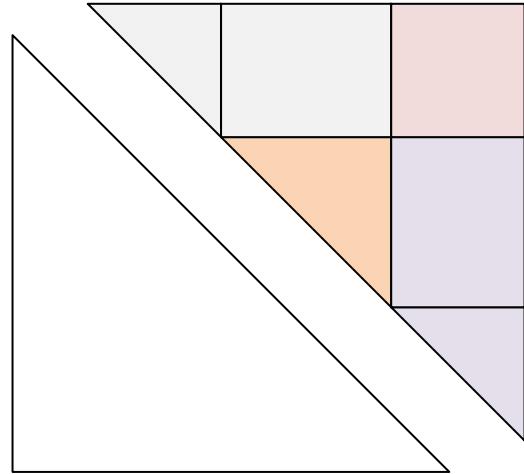


4. Sew piece **E** to the other **AB** unit and press the seam allowance towards the **E** piece.



5. Sew the **ABC** unit to the **ABE** unit. Press the seam allowance towards the **ABE** unit.

6. Finally, sew the **D** piece to the pieced unit. Press the seam allowance towards the **D** piece.
