

Crossed Paths

Finished block size 8" (unfinished 9")

Cutting:

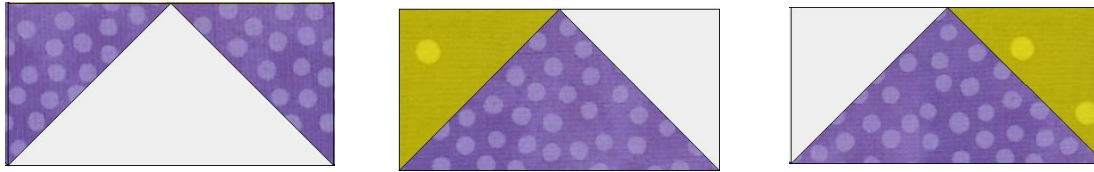
Colour 1 (shown as gray): 1 square 5.5" x 5.5"
2 rectangles 4.5" x 2.5"
4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Colour 2 (shown green): 1 square 5.5" x 5.5"
4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Colour 3 (shown purple): 4 rectangles 4.5" x 2.5"
4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

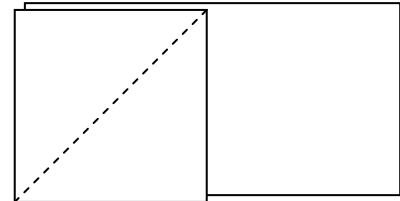
1. Cut each 5.5" square diagonally twice to make 4 triangles each. Using two triangles of each colour, piece together for the center square. Trim to 4.5". (or use your own method of making HST and QST blocks)

2. Make two flying geese blocks in each of these combinations:

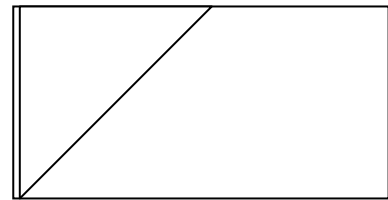


Assembly of flying geese units:

a). Draw diagonal lines on the backs of all the 2.5" x 2.5" squares.

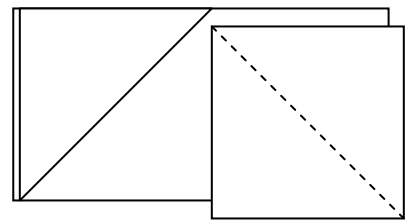


b). Place a 2.5" square on a 2.5" x 4.5" rectangle, right sides together, and sew on the drawn line.



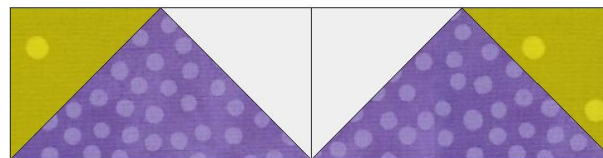
(Note: Your blocks pieces should overlap completely, not as drawn for illustrative purposes only!)

c). Fold the triangle back and press. Trim away the bottom two layers.



d). Sew a second square on each unit as illustrated, pressing and trimming as before.

3. Sew the units together as illustrated.



4. Bulk is reduced by pressing seams open.
