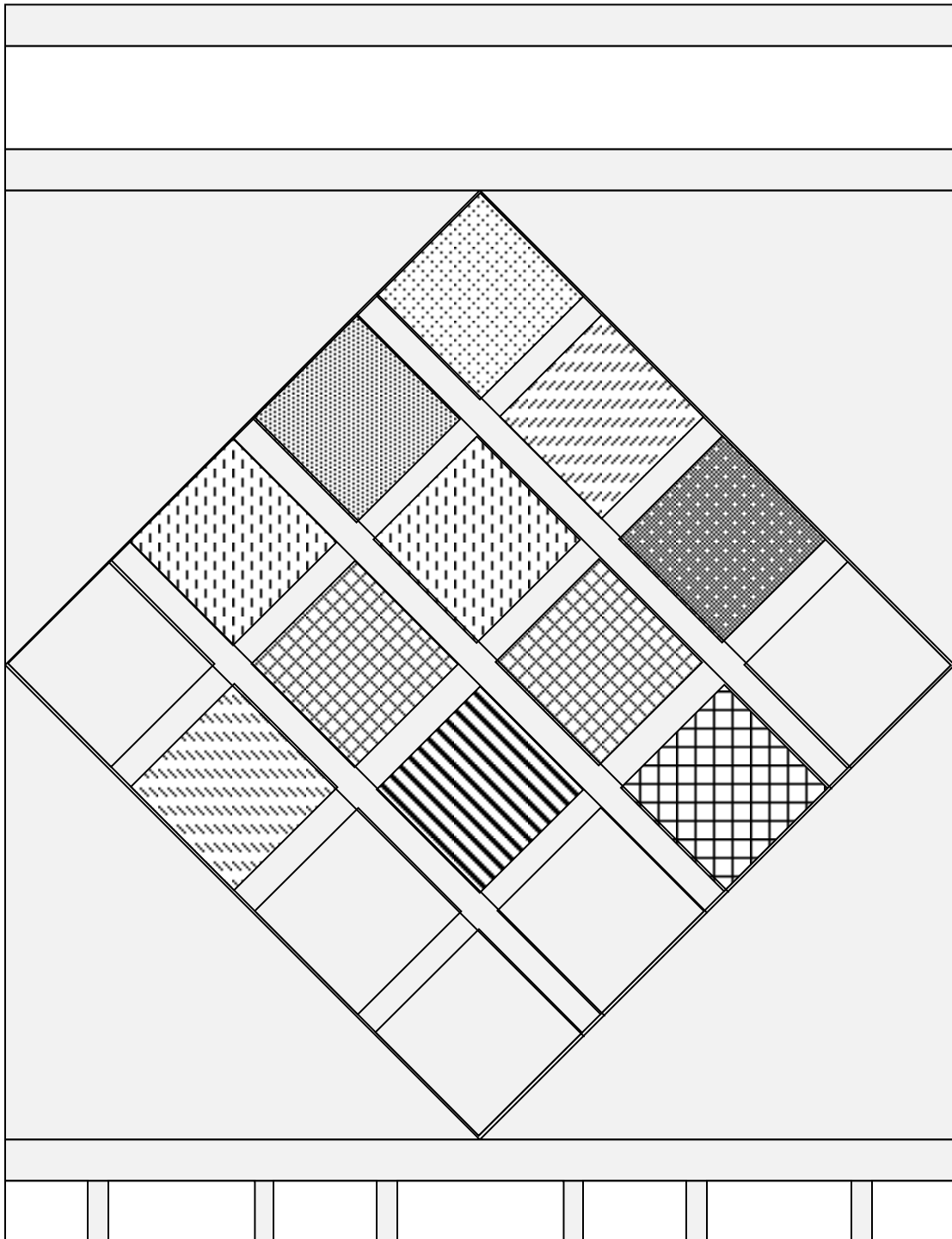


Deb's Modern BOM Quilt

Notes:

Drawing is not to scale! Textured areas represent the pieced blocks

All shaded areas are solid colour All white areas are accent fabrics



Cutting of solid fabric:

1. Five squares 8.5" x 8.5"
2. All sashing is cut at 2" x WOF, including long sashing at top and bottom (remember the diagram is not to scale!) you will need 9 strips.
 - A. Cut 12 pieces 8.5" and 3 pieces 37" long for the sashing between the blocks
 - B. Cut 6 pieces 3.25" long
 - C. Piece the remaining strips as needed to make the two top and one bottom sashing the width of the quilt (approximately 51 inches – measure after the large triangles are sewn to the central section).
3. For the setting triangles, two squares 27" x 27", cut in half diagonally.
4. Top accent strip: 7" x "51" – piece to achieve length
5. Bottom accent pieces:
 - 2 pieces 2.5" x 3.25"
 - 2 pieces 5.75" x 3.5"
 - 3 pieces 8.5" x 3.25"

Assemble in units:

1. Assemble the central pieces using BOM blocks, solid 8.5" squares. And sashing.
2. Attach the setting triangles. Measure the width and adjust the lengths of top and bottom if needed.
3. Sew sewing strips on either side of the long accent piece. Sew to top of quilt center.
4. Assemble the bottom row with accent pieces and sashing. Sew to bottom of the quilt.
