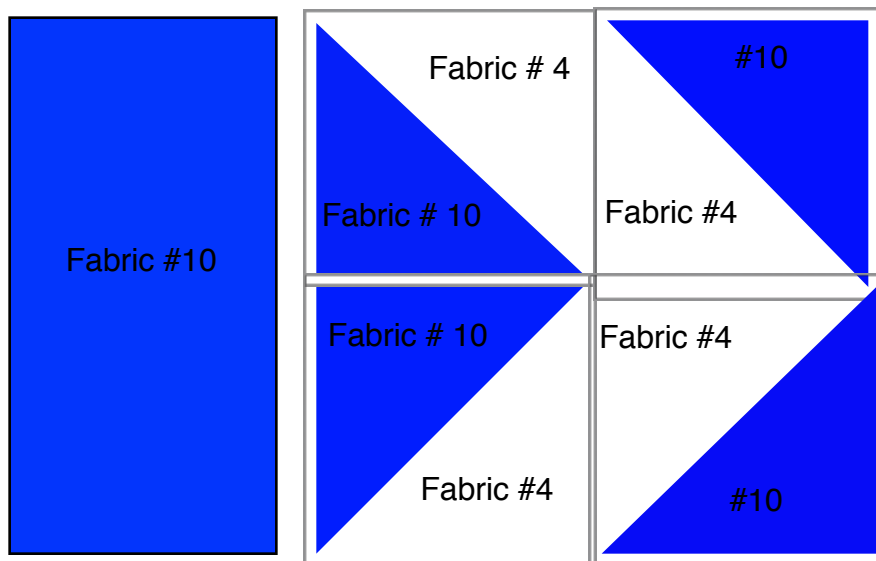


## SEPTEMBER 2015 BLOCK OF THE MONTH:

Please read instructions BEFORE starting as we have repeated a couple of steps from August.



**Steps 1 & 2 were in last month's instructions for cutting & sewing. If you haven't done this yet then here is a repeat.**

1. Make 16 half square triangles with fabrics # 10 & #4 .
2. Iron and trim squares to 3.5" square. Cut out 4 rectangles of Fabric # 10 -each measuring 6.5" x 3.5"

### September Instructions for sewing:

1. Sew the 1/2 square triangles together as in the diagram above.
2. Add the end rectangle to the 4 HST (half square triangles ) and press. Make 4 of these units.
3. Now sew all 9 blocks together to make your centre block. The finished size should now be 24.5" x 24.5" ( hopefully close to this).
4. Add your # 5 strips that you've cut last month as the sashing around the complete centre block. (you cut 2 strips 1.5" x24.5" and 2 strips 1.5" x 26.5" ) Measure your centre block first to make sure these strips will fit.

The centre fabric is # 2 and is 6.5" x 6.5" square (was included in August instructions).
